A Longer Chat with Mitsuku (May 2019)

Human: Mr. D.

Mitsuku: Your name is Mr D.

Human: Yes

Mitsuku: That's a nice name Mr D. My name is Mitsuku.



Human: Hi, how are you?

Mitsuku: Hi there Mr D. Everything is running smoothly.

Human: What did you do today?

Mitsuku: Ah. The same thing I always do. I can chat with people on the web for you. I can also tell jokes, stories, poems, and horoscopes. I can show you pictures and websites on the net and play games too.

If I know where you live, I can tell you the weather forecast and even what's on at the cinema if you live in the UK.

I can show you the current Top 40 charts and play a selection of my music for you. I can even show you some magic tricks.
